

TIMING GATES PACK UP

Where do I go when I arrive?

Upon arrival: Please report to the Parent duty sign in desk to check in for your duty.

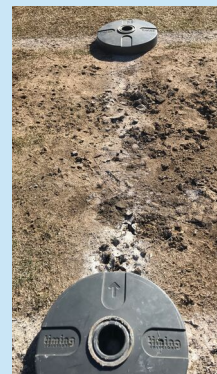
We use two sets of Timing Gates, which cover the 50m, 70m, 100m, 200m, 400m and straight-track hurdles events. The Timing Gates consist of plastic poles, which each have 4 sensors that detect when an athlete has crossed through the gate. These poles are seated in a weighted base and positioned at the end of each lane. Each set of Timing Gates are wirelessly synchronised to a laptop, which is set-up at the finish line.

How will I know when my duty starts?

You will either be called on the PA system, or you could ask the parents at the end of the track if it appears that the races have all completed.

Instructions for pack up

The poles need to be taken out of the weighted bases, by pulling **straight upwards (not twisting)**. Each pole can be put onto the circular slots on the trolleys, with the FRAGILE sticker/blue tops facing up. The weighted bases are then divided between the trolleys and the separate trolley lifters by putting them on the spikes.



It is very important to ensure that the weighted bases are evenly placed on the trolleys, with more weight towards the front (where the trolley handle is). Failure to do this can result in the trolley tipping up whilst taking it up the path and damage the equipment.
